- **Have two letters of recommendation emailed or mailed to the Ralston Family Foundation (One from a PGA Member or a Club Professional)**
- **Write an essay about the biggest life lesson you have learned through the game of golf (500 words or less).**
- **Provide a brief explanation of your collegiate financial need.**
